- Discuss personal defensive mind-set and tactics (discussions & exercises)
- Qualification: live-fire drill that requires no safety or gun-handling errors under time constraint and 100% accuracy

- Sturdy Belt 1-1/2" width (thin fabric or flimsy leather dress type belts are not recommended)
- <u>Strong-side quality belt holster</u> (leather or hard polymer only - no cross draw or shoulder holsters (NO FLIMSY CLOTH OR POUCH TYPE HOLSTERS)
- 300 rounds (minimum) of factory loaded ammunition
